Fall Session: Tuesday, October 14: Raptors of Minnesota 1-2p.m.

We learn about the different raptors found in Minnesota and their role in the environment. Participants learn the three key features of all raptors and learn how they are different from other birds. We discuss the positive and negative impact humans have on our environment, and participants are inspired by some of our greatest environmental success stories, such as the peregrine falcon and the bald eagle. This program includes a variety of live raptors.

Spring Session: Tuesday, April 14: All About Owls 1-2p.m.

Participants have the opportunity to debunk some of the cultural myths and legends associated with owls and learn about owl's natural behavior. We discuss the importance of owls in of web of life. The sixty minute program includes a variety of live owls and the use of hands-on teaching tools including owl pellets.
